



## Home Run Derby Rules

All players must present a valid Duquesne ID prior to the start of the Tournament.

**NO ID, NO PLAY, NO EXCEPTIONS**

Participants will not be allowed on the field until the preceding game on their field is finished.

### ATTIRE

- Participants must remove all jewelry prior to competing.
- Athletic shoes and athletic attire are required for participation. Unacceptable attire includes jeans, jean shorts, khaki pants/shorts, button down shirts, hiking boots, and street shoes.
- **Items of clothing with profanity will not be tolerated**

### EQUIPMENT

- Participants must use the wiffleballs and bats provided by the Rec Services Office.

### MISC.

- Each participant will receive 10 swings. Foul balls and swinging strikes will count toward the 10-swing total.
- A batter may select a pitcher from the IM staff provided.
- A batter will be allowed a total of 20 pitches or 10 swings whichever comes first 3.
